Nestled in the wooded foothills of the Manzanos (Spanish for apples), Manzano Mountains State Park is an excellent place for birding, photography, hiking, and camping.

A forest of ponderosa pine, Gambel's oak and alligator juniper provides abundant habitat for a rich diversity of wildlife. Watch for Abert's squirrel, Steller's jay, mule deer and black bear, among many others.

The Manzano Mountains play an important role as a raptor flyway. Some birds may fly 200 miles in a day and several thousand miles in a season. The park has a field checklist available to visitors who enjoy birding. While camping at Manzano consider spending a day at the Hawk Watch site on top of nearby Capilla Peak (August - October).

The park has about five miles of interconnecting hiking trails and a marked nature trail. Trails wind through the forest, circling the main section of the park, where the campground, office, and other facilities are located. Easy to moderate, the trails are fairly flat and bordered with rock and oak.

The park is open from April 1 to November 1.

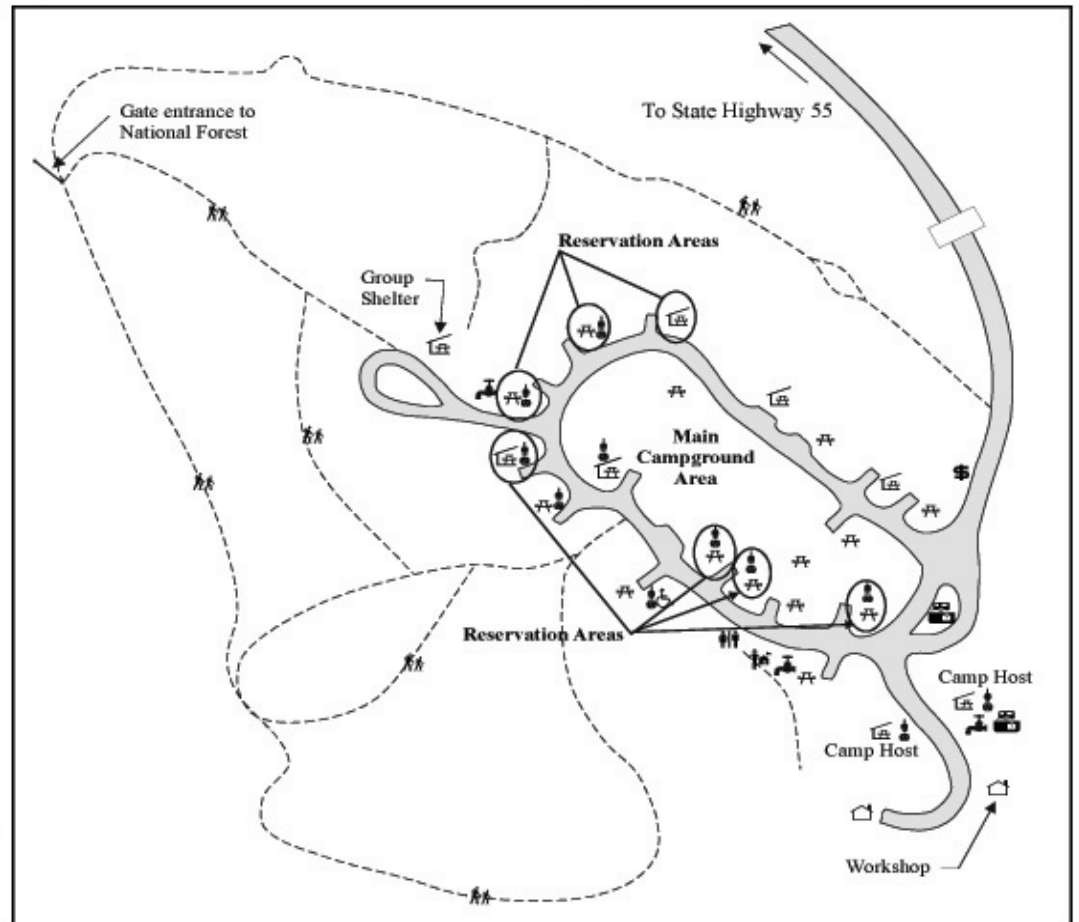
